The 5th Academic Council Meeting was held on 20th June 2019 at 10.45 Am.

The members of the council were welcomed by the chairman.

All members introduced themselves.

The minutes of the last Academic Council Meeting was read out.

I. The syllabi of UG and PG courses for 2019-20 academic year was presented by Heads of the Departments concerned. The following suggestions were given by the council members.

a). Preamble has to be given for all ~~course~~ programmes. Objectives have to be given for all courses.

b). Course outcome, knowledge level and credits should be verified for a few courses.

c). Analytical part needs to be given due importance in all programmes.

d). UGC guidelines have to be followed for OBE quantitatively in ^{due course}.

II. Approval was granted for conducting Add-on courses for UG programmes from 2019-20 academic year. The students who earned 3 credits through Add-on courses may be allowed to skip one elective paper in the final year. This has to be confirmed after verifying TANVISHA regulations.

III. The Question Paper Pattern for both UG and PG programmes was approved as follows.

PART-A. 10 objective type questions \times 1 mark. = 10 mks.

PART-B. 5 two-mark questions \times 2 mark = 10 mks.

PART-C. 5 questions with internal choice (5 \times 5) = 25 mks.

PART-D. 3 questions to be answered out of 5 (3 \times 10) = 30 mks.




IV. Open Book Examination may be given for P.G Science courses at the end of the academic year i.e. I & II year.


V. Those who complete SHAYAM online course successfully will be give 1 extra credit. This for those who got admitted in 2017-18 and 2018-19.


VI. B.Voc. courses was represented to the Academic Council.
