Assessments of the students are carried out continuously using formative modes as well as summative assessment, incorporating innovative methods like individualized assignments, mini-projects and projects.

#### Choice Based Credit System

The Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) gives freedom to the students to study papers of their choice. The CBCS as recommended by the TANSCHE is being followed from the academic year 2015-2016 onwards. Credits vary in proportion with the instructional hours and the nature of the syllabus content.

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A total of minimum 140 credits are prescribed for the Undergraduate Programme offered in three years and for a PG Programme offered in two years a total of minimum 90 credits are prescribed.

## question paper pattern

The question papers are prepared to assess the Programme outcomes in terms of the student's learning in cognitive domains, problem solving and ability to use novel tools and methods with respect to theory and laboratory courses enrolled.

#### **About COE office**

We have integrated with all provisions for Planning, Conduct, Evaluation and declaration of results for UG and PG programmes under the purview of Autonomous stream from the academic year 2015-2016. The research programmes M.Phil. and Ph.D. will remain under the control of the parent university. Regarding Students Attendance and the distribution of Internal and External components the parent university norms will be followed.

According to the guidelines of the UGC we constitute an Examination Cell headed by the COE on the basis of the potential of the person nominated by the Principal. The team shall consist of an Additional COE, Deputy COEs, Examination Co-ordinator, Technical Assistant and an office assistant.

#### Functions and Responsibilities of COE Office

#### Academic Plan / Announcement of Examination Schedules

Academic plan for the forthcoming year shall be prepared in advance includes the schedules of CIA/Model/ESE Examinations and other important events. The schedule for continuous assessment tests, practical examinations and End Semester Examinations is announced to all the students, at least two weeks in advance through the respective Departments.

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## Appointment of the question paper Setters / Scrutiny member

Question paper setters and Scrutiny members are appointed in consultation with the principal, time-to-time, from the approved list. The Question paper setters and Scrutiny members are called based upon their experience 10 years and above preferably with doctoral degree. The question papers received from the setters shall be confidentially and meticulously scrutinized by the board in the office of the Controller.

### Issue of Examination Application and Hall Tickets

The examination applications are issued one month before the commencement of End Semester Examinations with necessary details like student's data, paper code, paper name and fees details. The hall tickets for the End Semester Examinations, along with the date, time and duration is issued to the eligible students, at least three days before the commencement of examinations through the respective Departments.

## Conduct of Examination - CIA & End Semester Examinations

The CIA/ End Semester Examinations are conducted as per the examination policy and guidelines approved by the Academic Council.

## Appointment of Chief Superintendent, Squad & Invigilators

The Principal of the college will act as Chief Superintendent and based on the experience, qualification and their academic credentials Squad members and Invigilators are appointed by the Controller of Examinations in consultation with the Head of the Institution.

#### Appointment of Chief Examiners and Examiners for Valuation

The Chief Examiner shall be a faculty member at least 6 years of teaching experience in the relevant subject. The Examiners, for paper valuation, shall have more than three years of teaching experience. Additionally, such examiners shall have handled the regular/elective subject.

#### Evaluation of Answer Scripts

The commencement of theory paper valuations for the End Semester Examinations is announced at least one week in advance to all the examiners through E-mail. Dummy numbered Answer scripts are given to the examiners as per the allotment, not exceeding 25 papers for UG course and 20 papers for PG course per session.

#### Results Passing Board / Publication of Results

Results Passing Board shall be formed as per the guidelines of UGC and affiliating University. Meeting of the Board shall be convened, to analyze the course-wise and Department-wise results with related statistics. The result will be published on the same day of the meeting.

#### Re-totaling / Revaluation of answer scripts

The students can apply for Re-totaling / Revaluation with proper application form along with the details of the fees paid for the same, duly authorized by the concerned Head of the Department. The results will be announced within seven working days.

### Conduct of Supplementary Examinations

A student in the final semester shall have an opportunity to appear in the Supplementary Examinations. The students who have one arrear from the first semester to the prior to the final semester or maximum two arrears in the final semester only are eligible to appear for the supplementary examinations.

## Issuing Semester/ Consolidated Grade Sheets / Provisional and Degree certificates

Grade sheets after declaration of the results of the revaluation shall be issued to the students within four weeks after publishing the results. Provisional and Degree certificates to the candidates after completion of the Programme successfully are issued after receiving the same from Parent University.

## Scheme of Examination

Any theory/practical examination is conducted according to the Examination duration Prescribed in the syllabi irrespective of total marks allotted for the examinations.

There shall be theory examinations at the end of each semester, for odd semesters in the month of November / December; for even semesters in April / May. However, there shall be practical examinations at the end of even semesters in general, with exceptions in a few courses as prescribed by the Boards of studies, concerned. A candidate who does not pass the examination in any course(s) shall be permitted to appear in such failed course(s) in the subsequent examinations to be held in November / December or April / May.

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All candidates admitted in first year, should get registered for the first semester examination, compulsorily. If registration is not possible owing to any reason including shortage of attendance beyond Condonation limit, belated joining or on medical grounds, the candidates are permitted to rejoin the course in the next year.
