INCREMENTAL IMPROVEMENT COMPARED TO PREVIOUS CYCLE

The institution has seen considerable improvement in the institution-industry collaboration and Consultancy in the past five years. More number of MoUs were signed by the college. As part of MoUs, various collaborative activities were undertaken. Students took up many projects, attended various training programmes, completed Certificate courses, participated in special lectures and undertook internships.

In order to give exposure to different competitive examinations right from TNPSC to Civil service examinations, the institution started an exclusive training centre, joining hands with SAI IAS Academy, Chennai in the year 2017 after making MoU. Slowly the success rate of students in competitive examinations is increasing.

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell is strengthened as per the recommendation of the NAAC Peer Team. The IQAC is functioning very effectively, concentrating and monitoring the core values of the institution throughout the year. The IQAC organized a two-day National Seminar on INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS funded Rs. 28, 000/- (Rupees Twenty Eight Thousand only) by NAAC.


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Free Transport facility to all staff and students was extended by the institution, following the report of the previous cycle. School fee partial waiver was extended to the children of the employees of the institution.

Research facility was increased with the commission of sophisticated instrument for research purpose. Multiplex PCR, Spray pyrolysis, Spin coating unit, Solar Emulator, Solar Concentrator and UV-Visible Spectrophotometer and See-saw software. The research environment is improved with the provision of Seed money and incentives for research publications to the faculty.

Feedback mechanism was improvised for better academic improvement. Various stake holders, students, parents, staff and employees were included in the feedback process of the institution.

Vocational and Skill development courses were introduced with an aim of increasing the employability skills of the students. The institution was granted 4 UGC-sponsored B.Voc programmes in the year 2018. In addition to this, more than 25 Value-added courses are offered to the students by the college in the past 5 years.

N-List and Delnet were procured for the library to increase the utility of online national and International journals.

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
