In Swayam nearly 150 students and 48 faculties enrolled their courses. The college is equipped with sophisticated laboratory facilities, spacious classrooms and well-stocked library. RESEARCH:

The college applied for grant to many organizations like DST-WOS, TNSCST, DRDO, DAE, INSA and CSIR as research grants to the department of Biotechnology, Mathematics, Physics, Computer Science and BBA. 




