#### Bore well /Open well Recharge

This institution does not buy water from outside. Instead, the water which has been saved in the pond provides sufficient supply of water to the institution. There are 4 bore wells which help to get approximately 4000 to 8000 liters every day. In order to recharge the bore wells, there are around 40 pits which are constructed in different dimensions are filled with coarse gravel for adequate infiltration of water. This helps in increasing the ground water level.



## 4. Maintenance of water bodies and distribution system in the campus

- ✓ The Bore well water is pumped into storage tanks located at different places in the campus. The water is distributed through pipe network.
- ✓ Drinking water is supplied through a separate set of distribution pipes and water for all other purpose is supplied through another set of distribution pipes.
- ✓ Periodical monitoring of pipeline connection and plumbing works are done to avoid the leakage of water.
- ✓ Press type taps are fixed in the mess to prevent the wastage of water during washing hands.
- ✓ In the hostel, to minimize the water usage, washing machines are provided for the students to wash clothes.
- ✓ Dish washer is provided in the hostel to reduce the water consumption.

✓ Water purifiers are provided in hostel and college for safe drinking water


